Brethren, see with what large letters I am writing to you with my own hand. For even those who receive circumcision do not themselves keep the law, but they desire to have you circumcised that they may glory in your flesh. But far be it from me to glory except in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, by which the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world. For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision counts for anything, nor uncircumcision, but a new creation. Peace and mercy be upon all who walk by this rule, upon the Israel of God. Henceforth let no man trouble me; for I bear on my body the marks of Jesus. The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with your spirit, brethren. Amen.

sunday before the Elevation of the Holy Cross—St. Helen traveled to Jerusalem in 325. She found that Emperor Hadrian had built a temple to Aphrodite at Golgotha to defile the place where Christ was crucified. Upon ordering the destruction of the temple, three crosses were discovered. Basil plants covered over one of the crosses. As is noted on our Archdiocese website, (www.goarch.org), "At the inspiration of Saint Macarius, Archbishop of Jerusalem, a lady of Jerusalem, who was already at the point of death from a certain disease, was brought to touch the crosses, and as soon as she came near to the Cross of our Lord, she was made perfectly whole. Consequently, the precious Cross was lifted on high by Archbishop Macarius of Jerusalem; as he stood on the ambo, and when the people beheld it, they cried out, 'Lord have mercy.' This commemoration is marked by a liturgical "season," beginning today with the **Sunday Before the Elevation**, and continuing into next Sunday, the **Sunday After the Elevation**. SPIRITUAL RETREAT – Please see the enclosed flyer announcing our Fall St. George Spiritual Retreat – an overnight pilgrimage to St. Anthony Greek Orthodox Monastery in Florence, Arizona from Friday, October 25th-Saturday, October 26th, 2024.

SPIRITUAL THOUGHT — Today, we commemorate the Nativity of the Most Holy Theotokos. The hymns of the Church remind us of Her great humility and obedience to God's Will, through which, together with the Holy Spirit, Christ our God came into the world to save us; for, He "freed us from the curse of sin, abolishing death and granting us Eternal Life." Thus, we see the connection between the Nativity of the Holy Theotokos and the crucifixion and Resurrection of Christ our God and Savior by way of the Holy Cross. From today's Gospel passage (St. John 3: 13-17), we understand that, "Moses lifted up an image of the serpent to cure the Israelites from the deadly bites of poisonous snakes (Nm. 21:4-9). This miracle-working image prefigured Christ being lifted up on the Cross. As believers behold the crucified Christ in faith, the power of sin and death is overthrown in them. Just as the image of the serpent was a weapon that destroyed the power of the serpents, so the instrument of Christ's death becomes the weapon that over-throws death itself...To show the reason the Son must be crucified ('lifted up' -v.14), Jesus declares God's great love not only for Israel, but for the world. This single verse [John 3:16] expresses the whole message of John's Gospel and indeed, of salvation history." (Orthodox Study Bible, pg. 1427). +FR. THEODORE
